

North Florida Livestock Show & Sale Health Requirements

Tranquilizer drugs and/or medicated feeds cannot be administered to show animals at anytime during the livestock show and sale. In most cases, these products cannot be administered within seven (7) days of the show. Some products have long withdrawal periods and there are others you might not think of as drugs which might leave a detectable residue that can cause disqualification. Use of drugs, in animals, not in compliance with the manufacturer's label as to dosage, time of withdrawal limitations and show regulations are PROHIBITED. The use of tranquilizers or diuretics or possession of same immediately prior to or after arrival at the show will be construed as tampering.

Check with your veterinarian, County Extension Agent, Agricultural Science Teacher or some other knowledgeable person **before** using a product. There are a number of products that are considered legal and safe. If you plan on using a natural product, inform the livestock show board of it in advance. Any drugs used must be approved by and administered by a veterinarian on show grounds.

The following is a list of drugs that are considered unethical and therefore illegal for use during the show. Any drug that contains this as part of its name or active ingredient is also considered illegal. Anyone found in violation of administering these drugs during the show or before the withdrawal period is of non-effect will be disqualified from the show and sale. The Livestock Association reserves the right to determine other drugs illegal that may have been left off of this list. Failure to comply with these rules forfeits any awards and or monies.
