

**North Florida Livestock Show and Sale
Policies for 4-H Division
Steer and Swine**

Purpose: 4-H is an educational program of the University of Florida/Cooperative Extension Service. 4H prides itself in providing educational opportunities for youth to learn more about their project interest. It is, therefore, the responsibility of Madison County 4-H to insure that youth are given quality educational programs. These policies are not intended to restrict any youth from participating in the livestock program, but, are designed to enhance the learning opportunities available to our youth. These policies were implemented in the 1997-98 4-H year and revised in the 2005-2006 4-H year.

- 1 Youth must be 8 years old by **September1** of the current 4-H year in order to participate in the 4H division of the livestock show.
- 2 Youth must be enrolled in 4-H by October 30 of the current 4-H year (complete 4-H enrollment form and have on file at 4-H office).
- 3 Youth must attend at least one livestock clinic offered by the Extension Office. All participants are encouraged to attend all three, if possible.
 - Nov Record Book Clinic
 - Jan/Feb Showmanship Clinic
 - Feb Grooming Clinic

*The 4-H Coordinator can provide youth a list of 4-H Clubs in your geographic area. If no club exists, a new club can be formed if necessary.
